Post-Traumatic Growth Model

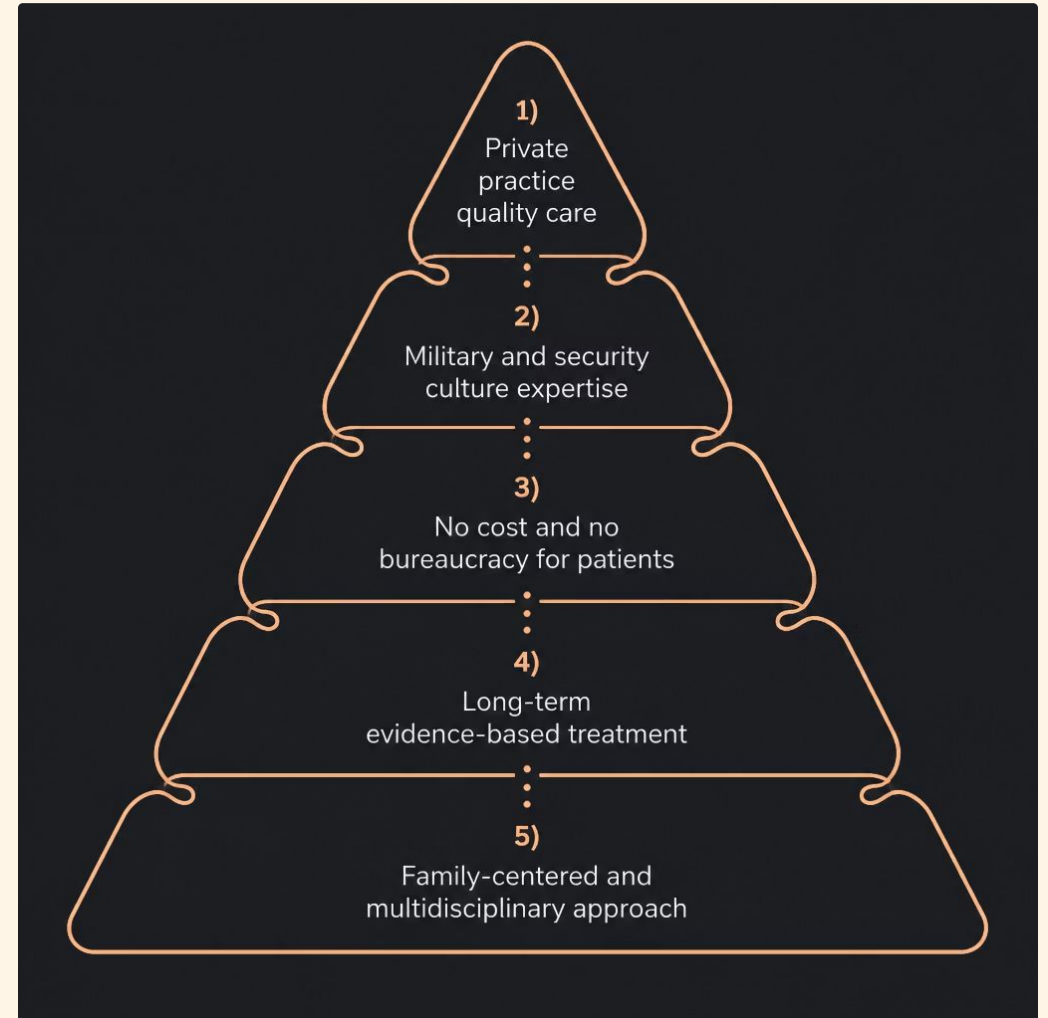
We go beyond symptom relief to help people rebuild meaning, agency, and hope.

We Save Lives. Literally.

Psychological Survival

Trauma left untreated becomes a slow erosion of self. We restore the person — not just reduce the symptoms.

Physical Survival

Nearly **1 in 3** of the people who reach us experience **suicidal ideation**. For them, treatment is the line between life and death.

Some of the people we treat, we pull back from real danger. Many more, we help reclaim their lives, their families, and their place in society.

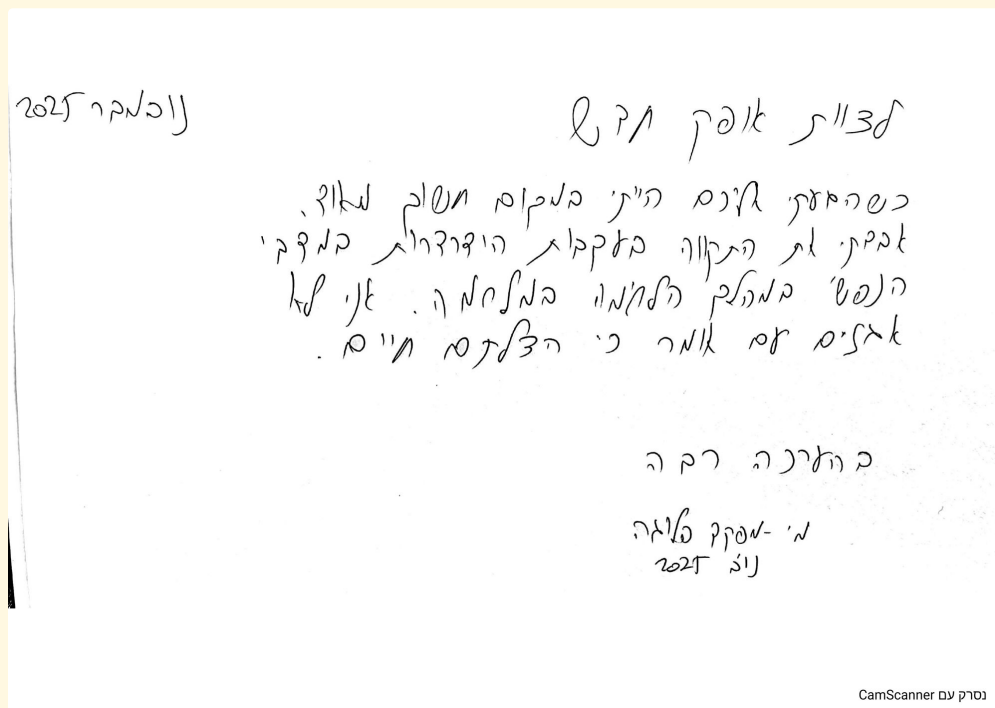
Treating combat veterans and their families strengthens Israel's national resilience across all sectors of Israeli society.



One Letter. Few Weeks After We Pulled Him Back.

M., a company commander, 28 years old, a combat soldier. He found himself in an extremely difficult psychological state. After a long period of treatment and risk management, a decision was made to fully discharge him from military service for the purpose of psychological rehabilitation — a process that caused him great pain, as his soldiers continued fighting without him. After the crisis he went through, he sent us the following letter...

When I came to you, I was in a very dark place. I had lost hope following a serious decline in my mental health during the war.

Structured Assessment

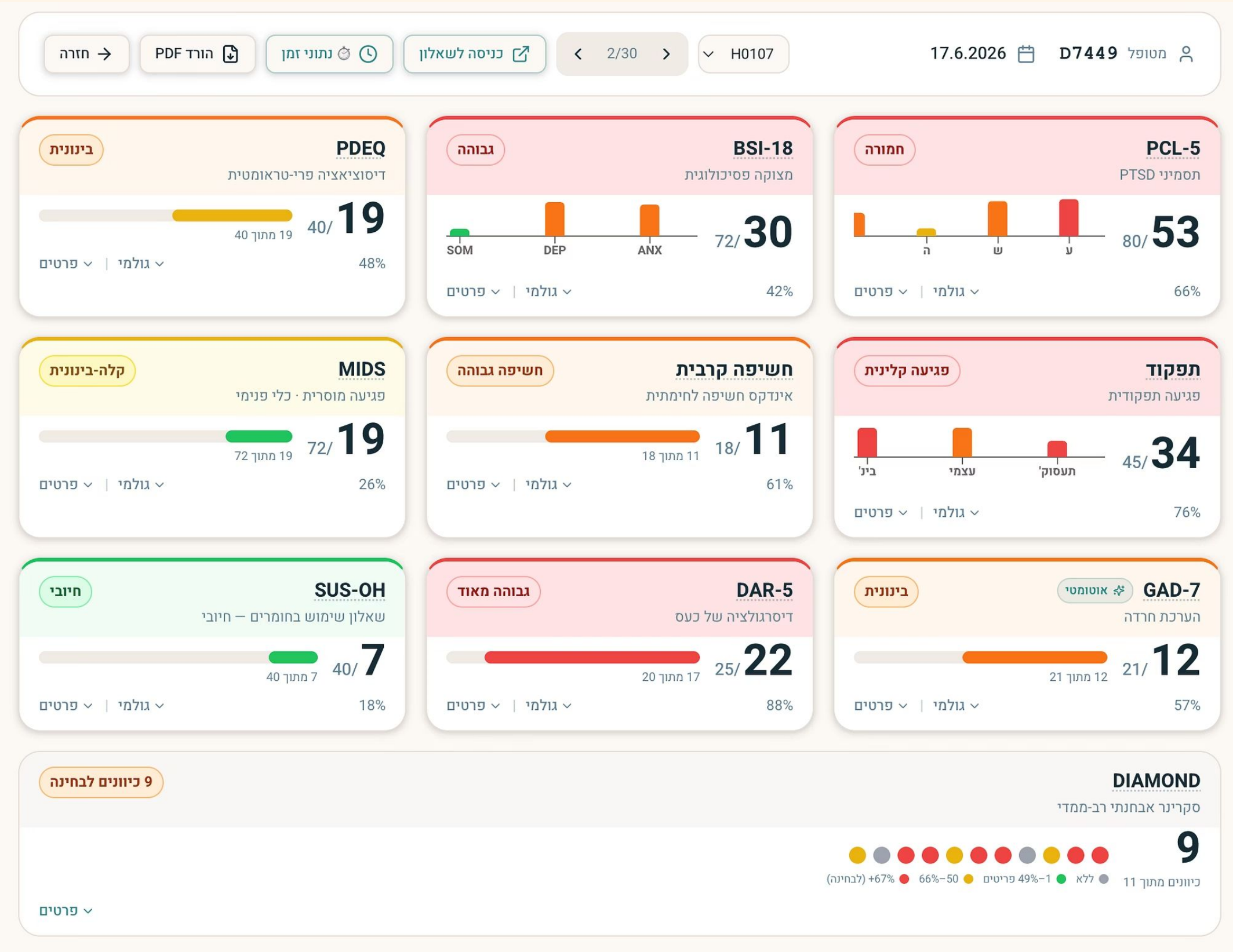
Every patient is evaluated with a comprehensive battery of validated clinical questionnaires.

Repeated Measurement

We track outcomes over time — a longitudinal picture of recovery, not a single snapshot.

Accountable Care

We measure what works, improve what doesn't, and show donors exactly how their support changes lives.

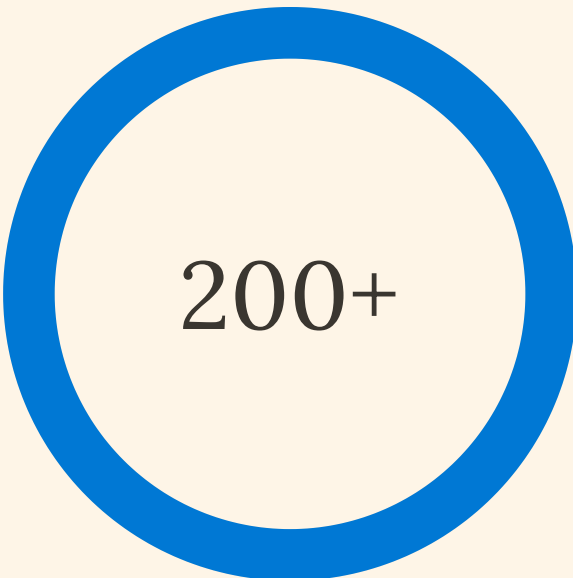

Direct Treatment

The clinician's hours with the patient — the core of care.

≈ ONE-THIRD • ~\$3,300

What Makes Us a Center

Beyond direct hours — the team, supervision, clinician training, and measurement that make us a center, not a single therapist.

All tiers fund one full year of care.

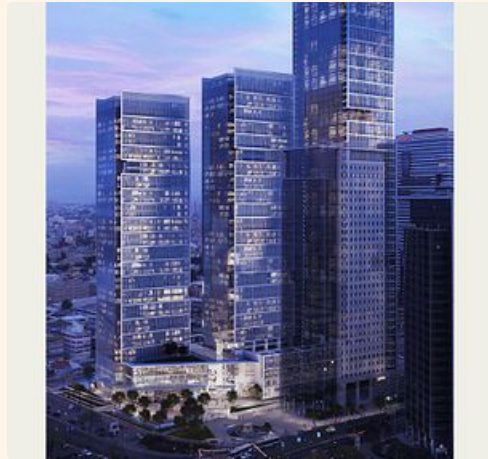
